

First Person Narration- Narration in which the point of view is that of the main character. (Pronouns such as *I, me, myself, we, and our*) (Other characters are still *he, she, and they*, of course.)

Third-Person Omniscient- this narrator can be like an invisible observer who is not a character in the story, but who sees and hears everything that takes place.

Third-Person limited- this narrator can also be halfway in-between: an invisible outsider, yet able to describe the thoughts of only one of the characters. Generally, they do not mention themselves at all.

Objective Narrator- This narrator doesn't have a personal opinion about the characters or events in a story. They tell a story as it happened, without adding his or her own thoughts about it.

Subjective Narrator- This narrator shares his or her thoughts and opinions about the story. Example of this is a first person narrator since they tell the story based on what they think and feel.
